Mark Anderson's AC Group survey of EMR functionality is one of the most respected and widely-circulated surveys in the HIT industry. Mr. Anderson, president of AC Group and IT Futurist, is a member of multiple healthcare organizations, a fellow of HIMSS, and a long-time judge of the TEPR and MS-HUG annual awards with more than 20 years working with physicians' offices. During the last three years he has spoken at more than 300 healthcare conferences and meetings.

The AC group survey is based on a 40-page questionnaire asking over 3400 "functional questions about electronic medical records (EMRs). The questions are divided among 24 categories and four methods of operations" and self-reported by vendors. The methods of operation include desktop capability, wireless capability, remote access capability, and mobile capability.

The survey is updated and published twice a year. In the 2003 Mid-Year survey, JMJ's EncounterPRO EMR ranked among the top 3 EMR's in 3 divisions of practice size.
